



Student Placement Guidelines:

- Please wear practical, comfortable clothing and shoes and bring your own clean wellies and waterproofs.
- Please bring food and drink for the day – we do have a kitchen with microwave, kettle and fridge you are welcome to use. We are not located near to any shops and you may be out on calls for the majority of the day depending on the time of year.
- Please bring uni work/revision for any quiet times between visits – we have an area for you to wait in and use during those times
- Please respect client and staff confidentiality:
(When you leave the practice each day, by all means, talk about what you have seen, but please do not mention the farm names or farmers. When you are on farms with us, if you do mention what you have seen elsewhere, just don't identify the farm by name)
- Please treat all staff with respect
